WHEREAS, the Alaska State Department of Transportation, as part of their biannual bridge inspections, identified structural concerns with the Cottonwood Creek and Twins II Bridges on Oilwell Road in Trapper Creek; and

WHEREAS, currently the two bridges and their abutments are substandard and at risk especially at high water events, spring breakup, and the fall rainy season; and

WHEREAS, the bridges are required for emergency, fire, and ambulance access for cabin owners and residents, and provide access to hunting, fishing, snowmobiling, mining, and the timber industry; and

WHEREAS, the bridges remain open but currently have a weight limit mandated by the Alaska State Department of Transportation and need to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$150,000 are available from Land Management fund balance, and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until a scope of work and budget is approved by the Assembly.
