**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 07-123**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$17,800 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR THE BOROUGH LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE, FUND 480, PROJECT NO. 20259, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008 OPERATIONS.

WHEREAS, the borough has received funding from the state to assist with the borough Local Emergency Planning Committee since 1991; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work and budget are contained in Resolution Serial No. 07-090; and

WHEREAS, the grant will be used to develop, maintain and update emergency operations plans and exercise those plans; and

WHEREAS, the grant will provide clerical support for the Local Emergency Planning Committee by the emergency services department staff during fiscal year 2008, by preparing minutes of the meetings, quarterly reports, correspondence, data collection, and other assistance; and

WHEREAS, funds will be expended on community awareness materials which will be distributed to the public; and

WHEREAS, the Local Emergency Planning Committee and the state have designed and facilitated exercises, which educate and train personnel in emergency preparedness.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby accepts the amount of \$17,800 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management.

Section 3. Appropriation source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby appropriates the amount of \$17,800 for the period of July 1, 2007, through June 30, 2008, to fund 480, project no. 20259, Local Emergency Planning Committee.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly.
