A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE FFY 2007 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM WITH THE ALASKA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, A 501C3 NON-PROFIT CHARITY PROVIDING HOUSING REHABILITATION SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough is currently partnering with the Alaska Community Development Corporation to provide housing rehabilitation assistance through the HOME Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program under the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG); and

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly wishes to continue providing housing rehabilitation assistance to low-income individuals and families in the Borough; and

WHEREAS, numerous HOME Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation projects are underway or have been successfully completed, a waiting list has been established, and the need for additional housing rehabilitation exceeds the current funding level; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Department of Commerce and Economic Development (hereinafter "Department") has authorized the Borough to apply for FFY 2007 CDBG funds on behalf of the Alaska Community Development Corporation to continue providing these services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough and the Alaska Community Development Corporation intend to apply for a grant in the amount of up to

\$500,000 from the Department, under the FFY 2007 CDBG Program, for

the HOME Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby authorizes the manager to participate in the FFY 2007 CDBG program and to apply for funds in cooperation with the Alaska Community Development Corporation for the HOME Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program.
