**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 07-127**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$70,000 FROM THE WASILLA-LAKES FIRE SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE, FUND 250, TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2008 WASILLA-LAKES FIRE SERVICE AREA OPERATING BUDGET, FUND 250.

WHEREAS, in fiscal year 2007, the Assembly appropriated Wasilla-Lakes Fire Service Area funds in the amount of \$600,000 to purchase two new super pumper/tankers; and

WHEREAS, additional funds in the amount of \$70,000 are required in order to adequately equip the super pumper/tankers with compressed air foam systems (CAFS) and bumper turrets; and

WHEREAS, there are not sufficient funds within the Fiscal Year 2008 Wasilla-Lakes Fire Service Area Operating Budget, fund 250, to purchase the equipment needed for the new super pumper/tankers in order to be in compliance and meet both Insurance Service Office (ISO) and National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standards; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla-Lakes Fire Service Area Fund Balance has adequate funds to fund this request.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Supplemental appropriation source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves the supplemental appropriation of \$70,000 from the Wasilla-Lakes Fire Service Area Fund Balance, fund 250, to the Fiscal year 2008 Wasilla-Lakes Fire Service Area Operating Budget, fund 250, to adequately equip two new super pumper/tankers with CAFS and bumper turrets.

Section 3.      Effective date.      This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly.
