A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A FEDERAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION GRANT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESEARCHING AND CREATING A HISTORIC PRESERVATION PLAN FOR THE COMMUNITY COUNCILS OF WILLOW, THE "Y," AND THE CITY OF HOUSTON.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the National Park Service Historic Preservation Act of 1966, certain federal share matching grants for historic preservation projects are available to certified local governments, and

WHEREAS, the historic preservation plan will involve the public process with presentations being given to various groups within those communities; and

WHEREAS, the end product will be a historic preservation plan that will become part of the Borough's overall comprehensive plan as part of Title 15 of the Borough code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby authorizes the Manager to submit an application to the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation, Office of History and Archaeology, for a federal share matching grant for the purpose of creating a historic preservation plan for the areas encompassed by the "Y" and Willow Community Councils and the city of Houston within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.
