**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 07-128**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$35,000 FROM THE BIG LAKE FIRE SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE, FUND 256, TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2008 BIG LAKE FIRE SERVICE AREA OPERATING BUDGET, FUND 256.

WHEREAS, in fiscal year 2007, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough received a 2007 Designated Legislative Grant from the Alaska State Department of Commerce Community and Economic Development to purchase a super pumper/tanker for the Big Lake Fire Service Area; and

WHEREAS, additional funds in the amount of \$35,000 are required in order to adequately equip the super pumper/tanker with a compressed air foam system (CAFS) and bumper turret; and

WHEREAS, there are not sufficient funds within the Fiscal Year 2008 Big Lake Fire Service Area Operating Budget, fund 256, to purchase the equipment needed for the new super pumper/tanker in order to be in compliance and meet both Insurance Service Office (ISO) and National Fire Protection (NFPA) standards; and

WHEREAS, the Big Lake Fire Service Area Fund Balance has adequate funds to fund this request.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Supplemental appropriation source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves the supplemental appropriation of \$35,000 from the Big Lake Fire Service Area Fund Balance, fund 256, to the fiscal year 2008 Big Lake Fire Service

Area Operating Budget, fund 256, to adequately equip a new super pumper/tanker with a CAFS and bumper turret.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly.
