AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A \$118,817 UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT AND REQUESTING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$6,253 FROM THE MEADOW LAKES FIRE SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE, FUND 257, TO PROJECT NO. 45123, FUND 405, TO PURCHASE SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS AND RELATED SUPPLIES.

WHEREAS, the Borough has been notified that the Meadow Lakes

Fire Service Area has been awarded a grant from the United States

Department of Homeland Security to Firefighters Grant Program;

and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used to purchase self-contained breathing apparatus and related supplies; and

WHEREAS, the fire service area is required to provide matching funds in the amount of \$6,253, in order to comply with the conditions of the grant and to receive the grant; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work and budget are contained in Resolution Serial No. 07-105; and

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. <u>Acceptance</u>. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby accepts the amount of \$118,817 from the United States Department of Homeland Security Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program.

Section 3. <u>Appropriation source</u>. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby appropriates the amount of \$118,817 from the Unites States Department of Homeland Security Assistance to Firefighters Grant No. EMW-2007-FO-10300 and \$6,253 from the Meadow Lakes Fire Service Area Fund Balance, fund 257, to fund 405, project no. 45123, to purchase personal protective equipment and related supplies.

Section 4. <u>Effective date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly.
