AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$67,000 FROM GOLD TRAILS ROAD SERVICE AREA NO.28 FUND BALANCE, FUND 282, TO THE GOLD TRAILS ROAD SERVICE AREA NO. 28 FISCAL YEAR 2008 OPERATING BUDGET, FUND 282.

WHEREAS, the crack sealing bid, the high cost of sand, sodium, and chips, and the sign supplies have seriously depleted the fiscal year 2008 operating budget for Gold Trails Road service Area No. 28, leaving a very minimal amount for any optional maintenance work or emergency work that may arise this fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department, Operations and Maintenance Division, desires a supplemental appropriation of \$67,000 from Gold Trails Road Service Area No. 28 fund balance, fund 282, the Gold Trails Road Service Area No. 28 fiscal year 2008 operating budget, fund 282.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Supplemental appropriation source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves the supplemental appropriation of \$67,000 from Gold Trails Road Service Area No. 28 fund balance, fund 282, to the Gold Trails Road Service Area No. 28 fiscal year 2008 operating budget, fund 282.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly.
