**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 07-161**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING MSB 4.46.030, HISTORICAL PRESERVATION COMMISSION, SPECIFICALLY TO CHANGE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Borough Code.

Section 2. Amendment of section. MSB 4.46.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(A) The commission shall consist of **NINE** [SEVEN] citizens of the borough who have demonstrated an interest, competence, or knowledge in the historical and cultural foundations of the borough and the state. To the extent available in the borough, the mayor shall appoint professional members from the disciplines of architecture, history, architectural history, planning, archeology, or other historic preservation related disciplines, such as urban planning, American studies, American civilization, cultural geography, or cultural anthropology.

[(C) THERE WILL BE TWO ADDITIONAL AT-LARGE ALTERNATE MEMBERS.]

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly.
