**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 07-167**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$85,761 GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TO FUND 400, PROJECT 40161, HOLLYWOOD ROAD SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT THE KNIK-GOOSE BAY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development has notified the borough of approval of a grant for Hollywood Road safety improvements needed at the new Knik-Goose Bay Elementary School site; and

WHEREAS, these improvements are needed to address life, health, and safety issues, and were identified and required by the State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities during the civil design phase of Knik-Goose Bay Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly must pass an ordinance formally accepting and appropriating the grant funds and no expenditures will be made until a scope of work and budget have been approved by the Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and appropriation source. There is hereby accepted and appropriated by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly a grant in the amount of \$85,761 from the State of Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development to fund

400, project no. 40161, for Hollywood Road safety improvements at the Knik-Goose Bay Elementary School site.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly.
