A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING THE NEED TO HIGHLIGHT BOROUGH PRIORITIES TO STATE AND FEDERAL LEGISLATORS.

WHEREAS, the Assembly approves Federal and State priorities on a yearly basis; and

WHEREAS, it is important to highlight those projects and place them in the forefront of the minds of the Legislators and citizenry; and

WHEREAS, the Borough can produce an annual picture/poster, similar to that of the Alaska Railroad and Iditarod; and


WHEREAS, the production of the artwork will cost approximately \$3,000 to \$7,000 annually; and
