Thank you for your interest in applying for an Absentee By-Mail ballot for the regular Borough election.

The Borough's 2024 regular election will be held on **Tuesday, November 5, 2024**. Regular Borough elections are held annually on the first Tuesday, following the first Monday, in November (MSB 25.05.030). Special elections may be held in accordance with Borough code. Absentee By-Mail applications for Borough elections <u>must be submitted annually</u> and are **separate** from the Alaska State Division of Elections and the Cities of Houston, Palmer and Wasilla.

In order for your application to be processed, please carefully complete **ALL** sections of the application (on the reverse side) <u>and SIGN.</u> Omissions or errors may cause a delay in ballot mailing. If there is a change to your ballot mailing address after you have submitted an application, it is very important that you let us know by calling 907-861-8683.

Ballots will be mailed out around October 16, 2024. Please apply early to allow sufficient time for a ballot to be mailed to you.

#### **DEADLINES AND DATES:**

- Application Deadline: Tuesday, October 29, 2024
- Absentee By-Mail Ballot Hand-Delivered by: Tuesday, November 5, 2024, 8 p.m. (Election Day)
  OR
- Absentee By-Mail Ballot Postmarked by: Tuesday, November 5, 2024 (Election Day) and received by Friday, November 8, 2024

### EARLY VOTING AND ABSENTEE IN-PERSON VOTING:

### **CITY ELECTIONS:**

Regular elections for the cities of Houston, Palmer, and Wasilla are conducted separately from Borough elections. To request an absentee ballot for city elections, you <u>must apply directly</u> to your city clerk's office. If you live within the city limits of any of these cities and would like information on city elections and voting opportunities, contact your local City Clerk's Office.

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### **REGULAR BOROUGH ELECTION: NOVEMBER 5, 2024**

#### **ABSENTEE BY MAIL VOTING**

- Any registered Borough voter may apply for a ballot by-mail by submitting this application no later than 7 days prior to Election Day.
- Complete ALL sections of the application and sign. Blank fields, omissions, or errors may cause a delay in ballot mailing.
- You must sign the application. No one may sign on your behalf.
- You cannot request and sign for an absentee ballot for anyone else, but yourself.
- Completed applications may be mailed, hand-delivered, or faxed to the Borough Clerk's Office (address & fax # above).
- The application deadline for the November 5, 2024, regular election is October 29, 2024.
- Once ballots are ready for distribution and upon timely receipt of a by-mail application, an official ballot and voting material will be mailed to the ballot mailing address provided on the application. Ballots will be mailed around October 16, 2024.
- Once you receive your ballot, carefully follow ALL instructions to ensure your ballot is properly cast.
- The returned (voted) by-mail ballot contain: Voter's envelope MUST signature, voter's identifier, and a witness or notary's signature.

- In order for your ballot to be counted, absentee by-mail ballots must be postmarked by Election Day and received by the Clerk's Office no later than November 8, 2024.
- Hand-delivered ballots **MUST** be returned to a Borough election official by 8 p.m. on **Election Day**.
