Things applicants need to know about the process: An application must be filled out every year. Apply early to receive your Borough Ballot in a timely manner. REAPPORTIONMENT PLAN After each federal census and adoption of a redistricting plan for the State legislature, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly is required to propose to the voters of the Borough a form of	 INCREASING THE MAT-SU BOROUGH'S SENIOR/DISABLED VETERAN RESIDENTIAL OWNER OCCUPIED PROPERTY OPTIONAL TAX EXEMPTION FROM \$68,000 TO \$114,000 OF ASSESSED VALUE FOR A TOTAL EXEMPTION OF \$264,000 The Matanuska-Susitna Borough currently provides an optional real property tax exemption of \$68,000 of assessed value that is in addition to the State required exemption of \$150,000 of assessed value of real property owned and occupied as a permanent place of abode of a resident who is (1) Sixty-five years of age or older, (2) a disabled veteran, including a person who was disabled in the line of duty while serving in the Alaska Territorial Guard, or (3) at least 60 years old and a widow or widower of a person who qualified for an exemption. This exemption applies in addition to any other exemption applicable to the property. Currently, the total of the exemptions is \$218,000. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough proposes to increase the optional exemption from \$68,000 to \$114,000 for a total exemption of \$264,000 and provide that the optional portion of the exemption will be adjusted annually based upon the percentage change in the federal Housing Price

The Assembly proposes that the Assembly be composed of seven members, each of whom shall be elected from an election district by the voters of the district. The boundaries of each election district are shown on a map available and posted at each polling place in the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.
