<u>Matanuska Townsite Cleanup</u>: The Matanuska Townsite cleanup was completed the week of July 13. All trash was hauled. There were a total of 10 trash loads of approx. 63.4 tons of trash. At the site, there are still several piles of covered hazardous waste. The EPA contractor indicated that those will be covered for now. They will return in September to haul those away. There are also a number of vehicles at the site that still need to be removed. Overall, the cleanup was very successful. Here are a few pictures showing the improved area:











<u>Port MacKenzie Rail Extension Farm Values</u>: The Borough hired Black-Smith, Bethard & Carlson, LLC, to appraise the value of two farms acquired for the Port MacKenzie Rail Extension project in 2013. The first appraisal report was received on June 7, 2023, for an appraisal value of \$1,297,000, known as the Byler Farm (Parcel 32). The second appraisal report was received on June 26, 2023, for an appraised value of \$1,350,000, known as the Hecker Farm (Parcel 31).
