Borough-wide Comprehensive Plan: The Borough is updating its Borough-wide Comprehensive Plan. Throughout this process, staff will work closely with community members, Borough staff and leadership, community councils, and the Planning Commission and Assembly to develop a plan to guide land use in a way that promotes economic development, increases our ability to deliver high-quality services, and manages the continued growth in population we are expecting in the Valley. Staff has developed a community survey and is taking responses until August 31. The findings will be presented to the Assembly at the September 26<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. Over 850 Mat-Su residents have taken the survey so far.
