<u>Distinguished Budget Presentation Award</u>: The Borough was informed last week that our budget document has been awarded the Distinguished Budget Presentation Award from the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) for the current fiscal year. This award is the highest form of recognition in governmental budgeting. Stewarding and communicating how we spend taxpayer dollars is one of the most important things we do, so I would be reluctant to take for granted the work our budget team puts into our annual budget document and the development process.

<u>Talkeetna Revetment Update</u>: On Tuesday, September 19, the Borough received quotes for roughly 3,000 tons of riprap. The material is being stockpiled for repairs to the Talkeetna revetment. Western Construction commenced hauling late last week. On Wednesday, September 20, the Borough received quotes to conduct revetment repairs. Delivery and repair efforts are underway this week and should be complete by mid-October.

Work is estimated to cost roughly \$500,000; however, it may vary depending on conditions. We will seek reimbursement for these emergency repairs and have requested additional resources

from the US Army Corps of Engineers for a longer-term solution. An informational memorandum will be included in next week's meeting agenda to document the process and costs thus far.
