Final Results of Land Sale TS44:

The Tax and LID Foreclosure Sale TS44 was successfully concluded with the competitive sealed bid and outcry sales held on October 28, 2023 in the Borough Gym. The sale was conducted according to Alaska State Statutes (AS 29.45.460-480) and Matanuska- Susitna Borough Code (23.10.220).

Tax Sale 44 (TS44) saw \$1,577,450 in tax assessed value returned to the tax rolls by either the repurchase of property by former record owners, or by the sale of property via the sealed bid or outcry auctions. Only one parcel out of 33 remaining sale parcels did not receive a bid. That parcel will be offered at future over-the-counter sales.
