<u>Waterbody Setback Advisory Board (WSAB) Schedule</u>: The ordinance adopted by the Assembly forming the WSAB requires the Board to prepare a written report and for the chair to present it to the Assembly by September 17, 2024.

The WSAB has requested staff to prepare a resolution requesting a six-month extension to the Board so that they may solicit comments from community councils before presenting their final report to the Assembly. The WSAB will consider the resolution at their August 13 meeting.

The staff has drafted an ordinance for Assembly consideration granting an extension to the WSAB for an introduction on August 20 and a public hearing on September 3.

<u>Mat-Su Central School Tours</u>: The School District is offering elected officials tours of the new Mat-Su Central School as it is being constructed. The tours are every other Tuesday at 11:30 a.m. onsite just north of Pioneer Peak Elementary School. The dates are August 13 and 27, September 10 and 24, and October 8 and 22.
