EDUCATIONAL AND RELATED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS

This proposition authorizes the Matanuska-Susitna Borough to build the public school projects listed below and issue bonds in the amount of \$58,146,600 to pay for the schools.

Shall the Matanuska-Susitna Borough issue its areawide general obligation bonds in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed Fifty Eight Million One Hundred Forty Six Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$58,146,600), for the purpose of financing the cost, in whole or in part, of the acquisition, design, construction, major renovation and renewal of educational and related capital improvements within the Borough for the following Projects in accordance with and ratifying and approving the provisions of Ordinance Serial No. 24-072?

ABSENTEE BY-MAIL VOTING

Any registered voter of the Borough may apply for a ballot to be mailed to them by submitting an absentee by-mail ballot application. The application must be received by the Borough Clerk's Office no later than Tuesday, October 29, 2024. Applications are available online at **www.matsugov.us/**elections or call 907-861-8683 to request an application.

Things applicants need to know about the process:

- An application must be submitted every year.
- Apply early to receive your Borough ballot in a timely manner.
- Carefully complete ALL sections of the application. Omissions or errors may cause a delay in ballot mailing.
- Applications MUST contain the applicant's signature; no one else may sign for you.

PROPOSITION NO. 4

BOROUGH TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS PROJECTS BONDS

This proposition authorizes the Matanuska-Susitna Borough to build the transportation systems projects listed below and issue bonds in the amount of \$36,390,000 to pay for the projects.

in Shall the Matanuska-Susitna Borough engage the construction, additions, improvements, betterments, repair, reconstruction, and acquisition of public roads and pathways, and facilities related thereto, in the Matanuska-Susitna Borough of the following Projects, together with all necessary equipment and transportation facilities, including improving school access, and the acquisition of lands or rights in lands in connection therewith; and issue its areawide general obligation bonds, in an amount not to exceed the sum of Thirty Six Million Three Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$36,390,000) for the purpose of financing the cost, in whole or in part, of the following Projects in accordance with and ratifying and approving the provisions of Ordinance Serial No. 24-070?
