Old Glenn Highway MP 13-15 Flooding: Work to repair breaches from the Matanuska River continues. Work commenced on June 22 with the Department of Transportation (DOT) contractor, Mass X, to develop access to the first breach. Work on the first breach will be completed today. The breach at the Maud Rd. extension and another breach approximately 300 feet downstream from the first remain. MEA has demobilized as the flow has been significantly reduced from the repair of the first breach. Work will continue over the next few days. We will continue to provide updates on social media.

<u>Fire Resources to Support Interior Alaska Fires</u>: The following fire resources from the valley have been assigned to Forestry to support the Bear Creek Fire near Healy. This is a slight change from the update provided on Sunday, June 22. All assigned personnel from the various fire departments volunteered for this service, demonstrating remarkable support from our various fire departments for our neighbors.

- 7. City of Palmer Tender with two personnel.
