<u>Healthcare Update</u>: The Borough received its most recent employer healthcare quarterly experience report. With this report, we have the first half of the 2025 plan year costs. For context, total plan year costs for the 2024 plan year were 9% lower than the previous plan year. In 2025, halfway through the plan year, total plan costs are trending slightly lower than the 2024 plan year costs. These trends are primarily due to a decrease in large claims over the current and previous plan years. The plan continues to benefit from very good generic brand prescription utilization, which is a significant cost savings. Additionally, direct primary care through Capstone continues to see strong utilization. The Borough is working through the Pacific Health Coalition to negotiate with Mat-Su Regional Medical Center for additional discounts for hospital utilization.

Since filling the Healthcare Concierge position in November 2024, our concierge has assisted more than 140 employees with a combined total of over 500 documented requests submitted via email, in addition to numerous phone calls and walk-in visits. From an insurance perspective, she has addressed questions on billing discrepancies, interpreting insurance documents, understanding covered services, resolving HRA reimbursement issues, guiding employees through insurance portals, locating in-network providers, and coordinating with provider offices to ensure appropriate care is covered.

Additionally, she is the primary point of contact for employee communications, produces a healthcare-focused newsletter, provides presentations at both the department and division levels, and plays a key role on the wellness committee, supporting initiatives that promote and encourage overall health and wellness throughout the organization.
