- All classroom teacher positions are filled.




Veto Override: Update for MSBSD




- Veto override essentially equates to nearly flat funding from the State about a .3% increase
- Flat funding still requires cuts due to inflation
 - 159 positions eliminated across all employee groups
 - 15%-18% budget reductions across all departments and schools
- Veto would have resulted in \$7.1 million additional cuts
 - Some of those cuts were implemented already AND are being retained. Examples include:
 - Bus Routes Reduced
 - Transportation is currently operating at a deficit
 - Health Savings realized but to be determined.
 - Currently the budget relies on one-time dollars
 - Contracted services
 - Enrollment is uncertain and drives revenue



STATE FUNDING PER AADM




Enrollment Report: as of 08/25/2025





Administrators and staff are aligned working together for the achievement of established priorities.




All schools and programs will have consistently high expectations for all students.



Parents and guardians have tools and resources to be engaged in their students' education.




% of F and I for 2025 Semester 2






Math MSBSD and State over Time






