PLANNING COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 17-17**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH PLANNING COMMISSION
RECOMMENDING ASSEMBLY APPROVAL OF THE REQUEST TO REACTIVATE THE
FARM LOOP COMMUNITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, Section 2.76.040(B) of the borough code specifies that the planning department shall, at least once every three years, submit to the Planning Commission and Assembly a report and recommendation on community council boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the planning department conducted a community council boundary review in 2008, and following that review, the Farm Loop community council was declared inactive pursuant to MSB 2.76.030(C); and

WHEREAS, in October 2016, the planning department received a request from Farm Loop residents to reactivate their community council; and

WHEREAS, Farm Loop residents have submitted all necessary documentation that they are in compliance with the requirements set forth in MSB 2.76 for recognition.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Planning Commission recommends Assembly approval of the reactivation of the Farm Loop community council with the amended boundary to exclude any areas within the City of Palmer.

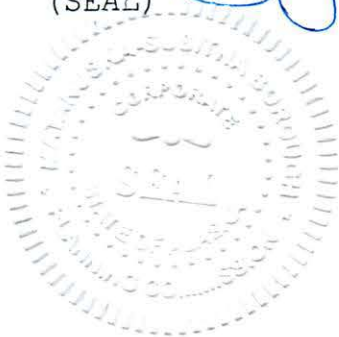
