A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH PLANNING COMMISSION REQUESTING STAFF TO UPDATE THE COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING PROCESS.

WHEREAS, guidelines for the Development or Update of Community Based Comprehensive Plans and SPUDs was last updated by the Planning Commission in Resolution No. 09-14 in 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough population has continued to increase; and

WHEREAS, 11 area comprehensive plans are currently in need of an update or re-write; and

WHEREAS, the current comprehensive planning process requires extensive staff and citizen planning team resources; and

WHEREAS, the current comprehensive process lacks direction on how to best receive input from all stakeholders within the planning area; and

WHEREAS, Community Council attendance and membership alone may not represent a full cross section of planning area residents; and

WHEREAS, community-based planning efforts should have a well-defined process so that the goals of borough residents are expressed in a productive manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Planning Commission hereby requests staff to prepare a revised comprehensive planning process policy for review and adoption by the Planning Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this new process should reduce the time needed to amend or create a comprehensive plan while utilizing planning staff in the most efficient manner possible.
