

Management of Cook Inlet EEZ Commercial Fishing

- Fishing season begins on or after the third Monday in June or June 19, whichever is later
- Next opening on Thursday, June 20, 2025
- Fishing periods
 - Opening day until July 15 Mondays & Thursdays, 7am to 7pm
 - July 16 to July 31 Thursdays, 7am to 7pm
 - August 1 to August 15, Mondays & Thursdays, 7am to 7 pm



Management of Cook Inlet EEZ Commercial Fishing


- NMFS monitors the commercial fishery daily with weekly meetings between NMFS staff and the Office of Law Enforcement
- All NMFS actions are published in the *Federal Register*, requiring 1 4 days (no "emergency order" authority)
- NMFS will close the fishery when
 - A total allowable catch (TAC) amount is reached
 - Data indicates continued fishing may lead to overfishing (e.g. run failure)
 - By regulation on August 15 (as in 2024)



Cook Inlet EEZ 2024 Season Summary


- Regulatory opening on June 20, 2024
- Regulatory closure on August 15, 2024
- 206 vessels participated generating ~965 fish tickets
- TACs were not exceeded






Cook Inlet EEZ *Sockeye Harvest








Cook Inlet EEZ Aggregate Chum Harvest






Cook Inlet EEZ Aggregate Pink Summary






Cook Inlet EEZ Aggregate Coho Summary
