## MSB FWC Questions Regarding 2023 Game Season Summary Meeting

### MOOSE

- 1. Does ADF&G feel that the moose population in Game Management Unit (GMU) 16B could sustain a general season (Harvest Ticket) hunting opportunity if the access to the area was increased by the proposed West Susitna Access Road? If not, what management steps would ADF&G likely need to take to ensure a healthy moose population was sustained?**

Increased access to Unit 16B by means of a new road would increase hunter opportunity and harvest. In addition to increasing harvest, it would distribute harvest to different areas that currently do not have good access. The area could likely sustain a general season (harvest ticket) hunting opportunity but there are several things that would likely change. The any-bull drawing hunts would be greatly reduced or not issued. Hunter success in certain areas would decline as harvest would be distributed to other areas.

We have a Tier II hunt for any-bull in Unit 16 which by regulation takes precedent over the general season permits. As a result, the Department may be required to restrict the general season hunt in Unit 16B-middle if the number of harvestable bulls drops below threshold levels.

- 2. With the past two winters of heavy snow fall, does ADF&G expect to see an issue with survival rate coming into the spring/summer of this year?**

The winter of 2023/2024 broke snow fall records in Anchorage. There are several places in Units 14A/B and 16 that received significant snowfall. Overall, Unit 14 reports of dead and starving moose were noticeably fewer this spring compared to spring of 2023. In Unit 16 there was some evidence of localized winter mortality of calves, but it did not appear to be widespread. As of writing this at the end of April I suspect that we will have good overwinter survival and I anticipate good calf production rates.

- 3. Is ADF&G considering any significant changes to the MSB moose hunting regulations for 2024?**

No significant changes are anticipated.

a) Overall moose population is lower right now than it has been in a while. The population in 14A peaked in 2017 and we have been intentionally lowering it until 2021 at which point we reduced antlerless permits, and the population is stable near the upper end of the population objective (6,500). In the other units that are managed from Palmer the populations peaked in 2017-2019 but began to decline after the winter of 2019/2020. We then had 2 consecutive winters with high mortality that reduced the populations. There are no hunts for female moose in these units and

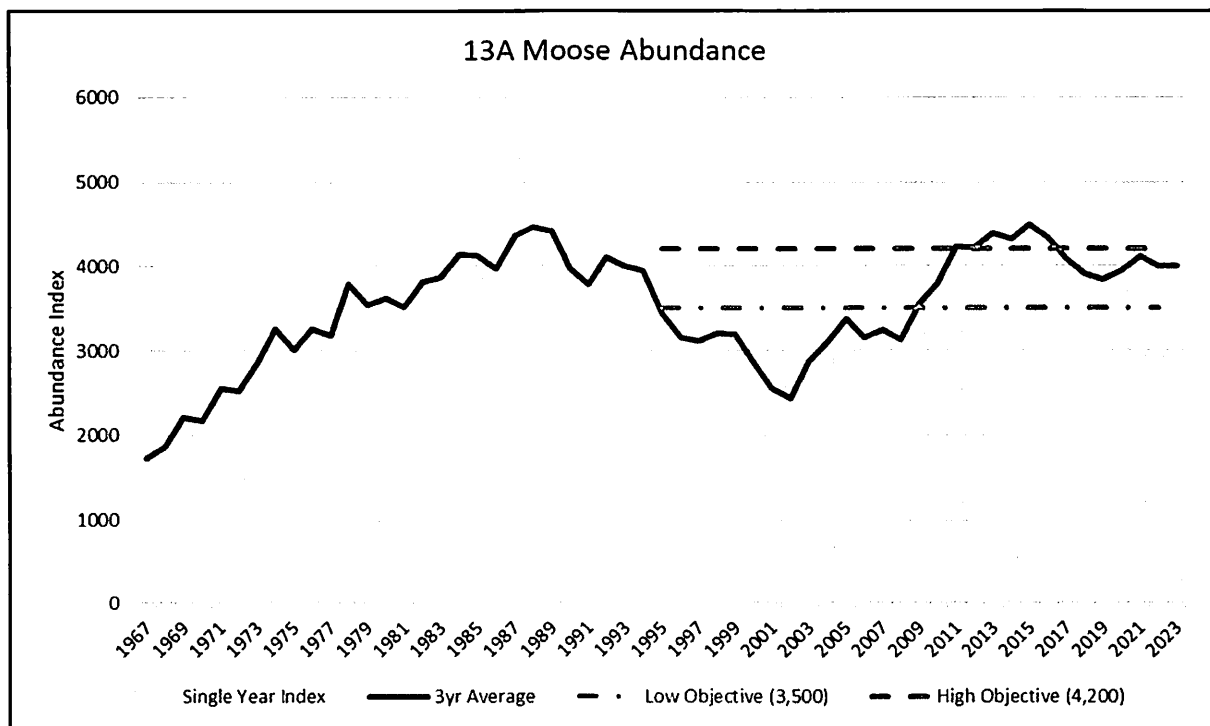
the hunting of bulls is not driving the decline of the populations. Predation is suspected to be the primary cause of low calf recruitment in units other than 14A. In Unit 14A and all of Unit 16 the population high in 2017-2019 was well above the population objectives and was not considered to be sustainable. However, we are currently at levels below what are ideal, and we are implementing practices to grow the population.

- b) Survey results are above.
- c) The surveys are organized by sub-unit and year. The type of survey is listed for each. GSPE stands for Geo-Spatial Population Estimator. It is the best survey we have if conducted in November as it gives us total population and composition ratios. Comp surveys only provide us with composition and not a total population estimate. Comp surveys are conducted when we do not have good enough conditions or funding for a GSPE.

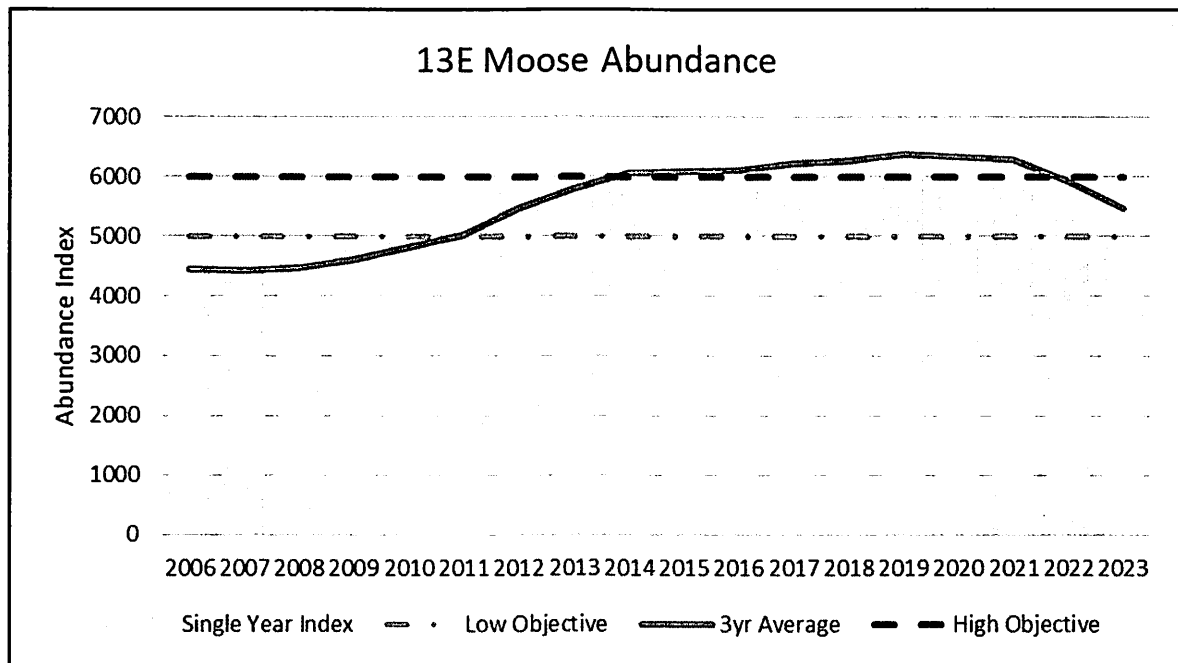
Units 13A and 13E

- a) Moose counts in 13A are slightly lower than in recent years, but still relatively high for that subunit. Moose counts in 13E have declined from a recent and likely unsustainable peak toward the lower end of the objectives, and wolf control was activated in RY23 in an effort to stabilize the population and prevent further decline.

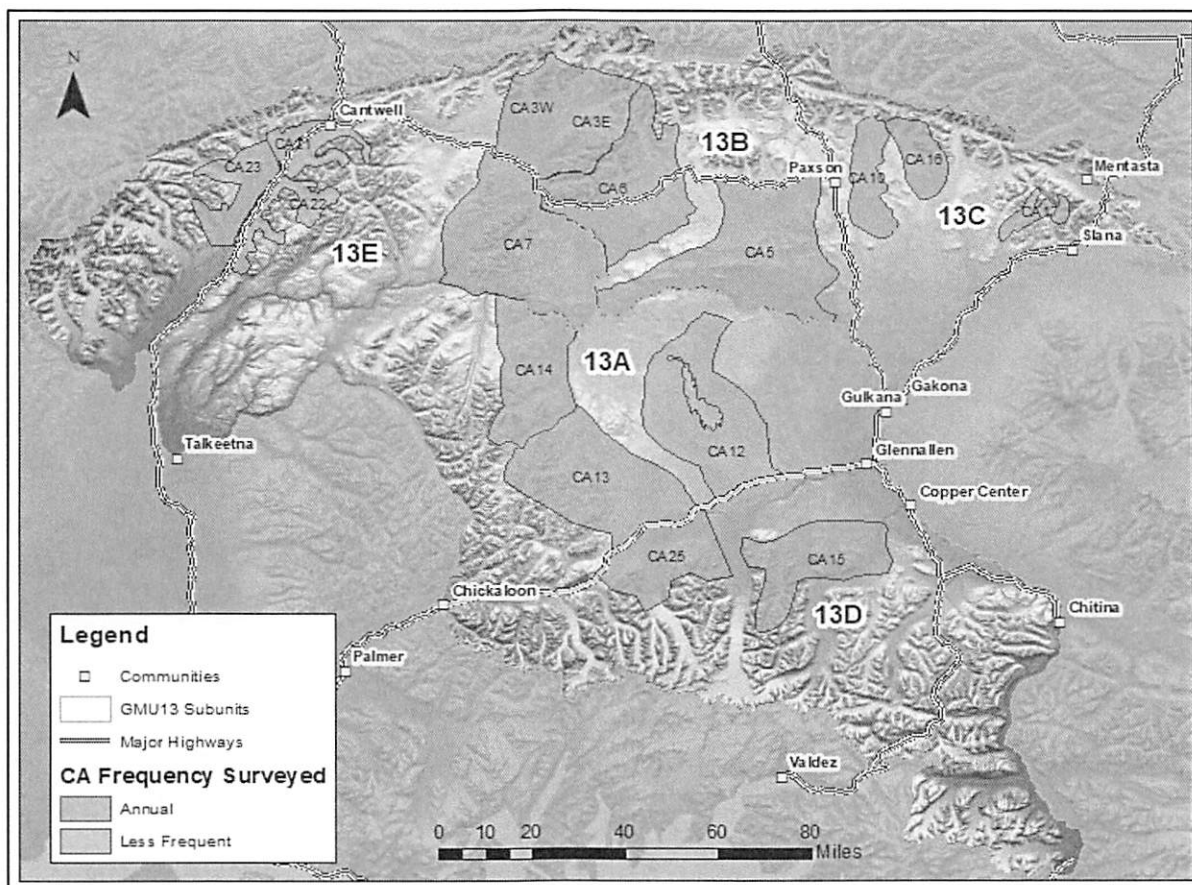

- c) Moose populations in GMU13 are monitored through annual trend count surveys conducted in established count areas (see map), which give reliable composition data for each subunit and an overall density of moose observed for each count area, which can then be extrapolated to similar habitat within that subunit to develop an abundance index for each subunit. Trend count survey timing and methodology have been conducted consistently since the 1960's.

We are more consistent with our Chugach surveys in 14A due to the drawing hunt in that area which requires more data to manage. The sheep populations were doing well and increasing during the last decade until several severe winters occurred 2019-2021. Not all surveys are complete and those can be seen in red. Weather conditions or the need to survey a different area sometimes prevent completing a survey. Overall, the Unit 14 sheep populations appear to be tracking what we are seeing with sheep statewide and the decline is not due to hunting or human disturbance.

### 8. GMU 13 Nelchina Caribou:

- Fall 2023 update: fall population estimate 6,983–8,344 animals with 25 bulls per 100 cows and 3 calves per 100 cows.
- Spring 2024 update: Caribou wintered ~150 miles closer to their calving grounds, experienced relatively low snow on the wintering grounds, and as of April 15 have exhibited much more normal adult overwinter mortality (~9%) compared to the previous two winters (25%–40%). Most cows did not have calves in the fall, which should contribute to better body condition going into winter, combined with low snow, shorter migration, and what is shaping up to be an earlier spring leads to a lot of optimism for this calving season.
- It is typical for caribou herds to go through cycles of peaks and declines, and the Nelchina experienced a precipitous decline over the winters of 2021/22 and 2022/23.
- We do not track trends specific to Unit 13E. Unit 13E is an area in which Nelchina caribou, Delta caribou, and Denali caribou travel and overlap during different times of the year. In some years there are more Nelchina animals that reside year-round in 13E, and in some years some animals migrate. Caribou are known for being unpredictable, and Unit 13E is a perfect storm with the overlap of 3 herds as well as localized groups.

**PREDATOR CONTROL**

11. Predator Control - GMU 16 and 13 (wolves and bears):

The department is not conducting bear control currently and does not plan to conduct bear control in Units 13 or 16. Wolf control began using permitted members of the public to use Same Day Airborne (SDA) wolf control in Unit 16 on January 1, 2024. This year the SDA program removed 61 wolves from Unit 16.

An additional 13 were reported harvested through trapping and hunting methods.

In Unit 13 wolf control began using permitted members of the public to use Same Day Airborne (SDA) wolf control in Unit 13 on January 1, 2024. This year the SDA program removed 176 wolves from Unit 13. An additional 56 wolves were reported harvested in Unit 13 by hunters and trappers, but harvest data is preliminary, as trappers still have time to get furs sealed from this season.

### **SMALL GAME**

#### **12. Where are we in the snowshoe hare population cycle?**

We are just passing the bottom of the cycle. There have been increases in small areas since last year. We expect to reach the next peak between 2028–30. There should be increases annually until the peak.

#### **13. How are the grouse and ptarmigan populations faring?**

Based on limited information grouse have been near the lowest documented from 2021–2023. We are currently conducting Ruffed Grouse surveys but at this time do not have any data to disseminate. Spring 2024 data should be available for this June meeting.

### **OTHER**

#### **14. Are there any hunter education programs that have been created or are being implemented within the Mat-Su Borough School District (MSBSD)? If not, is this a program that ADF&G feels would be possible to utilize working collaboratively with our MSB.**

There are a number of hunter education opportunities offered throughout the MSB including through the MSB school district. The Department's Hunter Education Staff are pleased with the current opportunities.

#### **15. How has draw tag participation trended over the past five years? If possible, break down the number of draw tags purchased comparing resident vs nonresident over the past five years.**

Please see additional attachments. The trend in purchase of permits and licenses has declined over the last 30 years. The last three years do show an increase in nonresident big game tags from an average 13,119 annually (2016–2020) to the last three years (2021–2023) at 15,563.

#### **16. In your opinion, what are the most serious issues facing wildlife resources in the MSB at this time?**

Land development is the largest wildlife issue in the MSB. There are 2 primary factors of development that cause concern.

1. Direct habitat loss due to conversion of habitat to roads, lawns, and homes.
2. Increased pressure on the wildlife by increases in users. As we maintain healthy populations of game but increase in the people who want to use them the individual success will decline.

Another concern for wildlife in the MSB is in relation to moose habitat. We have several areas that have traditionally been productive for winter moose habitat. (Pt. Mackenzie agricultural project, the Miller's Reach Burn, and the Mat Valley Moose Range Ruffed Grouse Project) all of these are over 20 years old. The moose browse in these areas has outgrown its primary benefit to moose. As such we expect to be able to feed fewer moose through the winter in the future.

## STATE OF ALASKA HUNT/SPORT FISH &amp; GAME LICENSES SOLD BY CALENDAR YEAR
