DISCUSSION: The proposed subdivision is creating four Tracts. The proposed subdivision will separate the rail bed interest from the remaining property. Access for the proposed tracts is from W. Holstein Avenue and W. Reddane Avenue, both roads are Borough maintained.

Topographic Narrative: A topographic narrative was supplied pursuant to MSB 43.20.281(A)(1)(i)(i).

Comments:

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Exhibit C) notes that the proposed Point MacKenzie Rail Extension does not appear to require permitting from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act and/or the Rivers and Harbors Act.

ARRC (Exhibit D) requestes the petitioner considers changing the name of the subdivision as the rail extension is much larger than the portion included on the agenda plat.

MSB PD&E (Exhibit E) has no comments.

MSB Development Services (Exhibit F):

- Permit Center: Notes that each access or encroachment constructed during the subdivision road development shall be reported to the Permit Center for documentation. Cluster box pullout locations should be designed using the MSB Standard Drawing Mailbox Pullouts, and in alignment with lot lines as shown on the plat layout. Any water system, sewer lines, or street lighting placed in the right-of-way shall require a utility permit.
- Code Compliance: No outstanding violations on existing tract 10 or 13 exist at this time. Code Compliance does not object to the re-platting of Tract 10 & 13 into four lots at this time.

<u>Utilities:</u> (Exhibit G) ENSTAR has no comments or recommendations. GCI has no comments or objections. MEA did not respond. MTA did not respond.

At the time of staff report write-up, there were no responses to the Request for Comments from ADF&G; Community Council #6 Point MacKenzie; Road Service Area #17 Knik; MSB Community Development, Emergency Services, Assessments, or Planning Division; MEA or MTA.

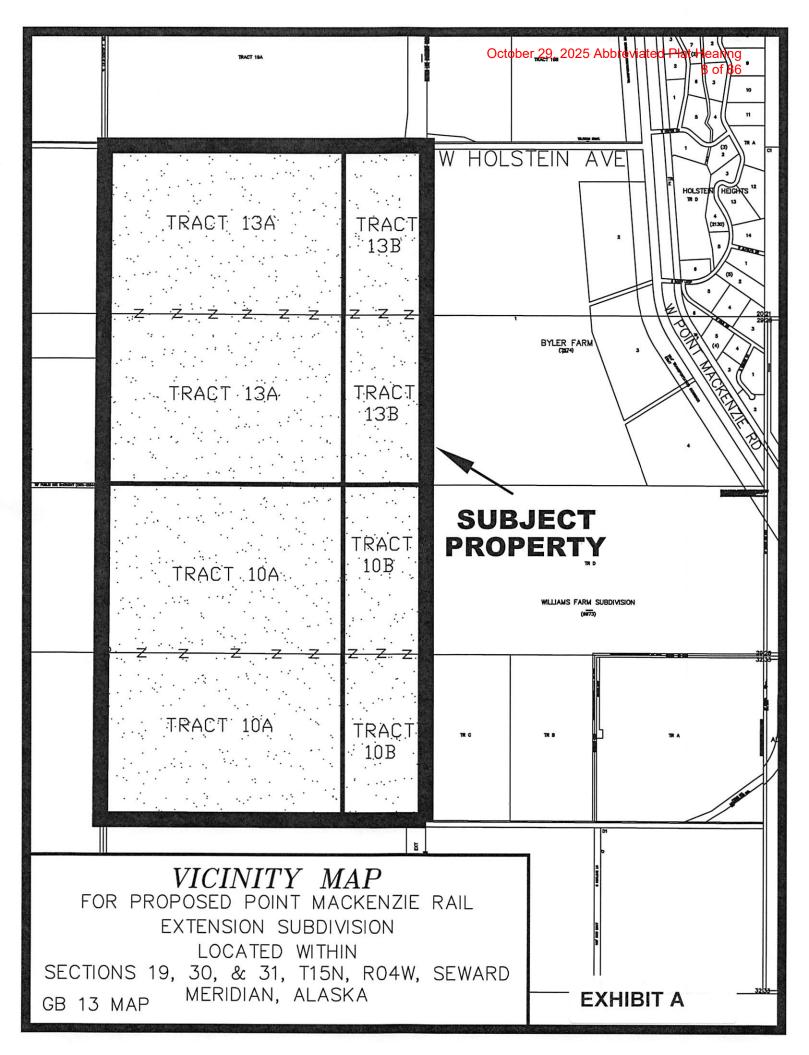

The following is an overview of the topographical nature of the subject tracts.

A large percentage of the topography of Tracts 10 & 13 is lightly undulating with minor relief. Much but not all of the native vegetation has been cleared for hay production, though stands of native woods and second growth remain. The general trend of the relief is mostly flat with shallow depressions. A view of the area using the MSB 2019 Lidar derived Hillshade, reveals evidence of a distant past scouring event and some small kettle lake like depressions. The soils appear to be mostly glacial in origin with low organic content. No significant flooding potential was observed.

REQUEST: The request is to create two lots from Tract A Little Susitna Ridge Subdivision, Plat 2021-69 and to be known as **LITTLE SUSITNA RIDGE ADDITION 1**, containing 52.90 acres +/-. The plat is located south of Little Susitna River, directly north of East Needham Avenue, and east of East Fishers Drive, located within the SE ¼ Section 7, Township 18 North, Range 01 East, Seward Meridian, Alaska.

AGENCY COMMENTS

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The proposed subdivision is creating two lots from Tract A Little Susitna Subdivision. Lot 2 is to be 2.01 acres and Tract A1 is to be 50.85 acres. Access is N. En Dove Rd. N. En Dove Rd is a Borough owned and maintained road.

Soils Report: A geotechnical report was submitted (Exhibit B), pursuant to MSB 43.20.281(A). Curtis Holler, PE, notes the soils evaluation included visual analyses of each of the lots, logging on one new testhole, review of topography information and direct observations on site. Grades over 25% were noted on the attached drawing. The total elevation differential is approximately 62'; The Little Susitna River bisects the property. A gravel pad, shop building, and loading ramp exist on the proposed lot 2. on the parent parcel; other than immediate clearing around the structures, the remainder of the proposed lots are treed with bushes and grasses scattered throughout. The new testhole was excavated on July 27, 2025 to 13.5'. Subsurface soils consist primarily of a thin organic mat and silty topsoils overlaying sands and gravel extending to 13.5'. Testhole log is attached. No percolation tests were warranted. No groundwater or seeps were noted. Based on the available soils and water table information, topography, Borough code and observations on

site, each lot will have at least 10,000 sf of contiguous useable septic area and 10,000 sf of useable building area within each of the proposed lots, with the river lying over 100' away from any potentially usable area. Separation to groundwater is not expected to be a limiting factor for the proposed lots.

<u>Comments</u>: Development Services (Exhibit C) comments that "each access or encroachment constructed during subdivision road development shall be reported to the Permit Center for documentation. Cluster box pullout locations should be designed using the MSB Standard Drawing – Mailbox Pullouts, and in alignment with lot lines as shown on the plat layout. Any water system, sewer lines, or street lighting placed in the right-of-way shall require a utility permit."

ADF&G (Exhibit D) has no objections. Noted: "Tract A Little Susitna Ridge Subdivision, Plat 2021-69 does contain multiple channels of Little Susitna River, which runs in the north end of the property. Crocker Creek (AWC: 247-41-10100) is a catalogued stream for Chinook, coho, chum, pink and sockeye salmon, as well as Artic lamprey. It has been determined that dividing the lot into two lots does not require habitat permit at this time but may be required a permit if the property owner intends to modify riverbanks, has in water work, or work at or below the ordinary high water line. <u>Utilities</u>: (Exhibit E) Enstar has no comments, recommendations or objections. GCI has no comments or objections. MTA did not respond. MEA did not respond.

At the time of staff report write-up, there were no responses to the Request for Comments from USACE; Community Council Fishhook Area; 132 Greater Palmer Consol; Road Service Area # 28 Gold Trail; Emergency Services, Assessments, Planning Division, Pre-Design Division; MEA, or MTA.

Public Comments: (Exhibit F) The perish council of St Herman's church fully supports the subdivision.

<u>CONCLUSION</u>: The abbreviated plat of Little Susitna Ridge Addition 1 is consistent with AS 29.40.070 Platting Regulations and MSB 43.15.025 Abbreviated Plats. There were no objections from any federal or state agencies, Borough departments, or utilities. There were no objections to the plat from the public in response to the Notice of Public Hearing. Legal and physical access exists to the proposed lots, consistent with MSB 43.20.100 Access Required, MSB 43.20.120 Legal Access and MSB 43.20.140 Physical Access. Frontage for the subdivision exists, pursuant to MSB 43.20.320 Frontage. A soils report was submitted, pursuant to MSB 43.20.281(A)(1).

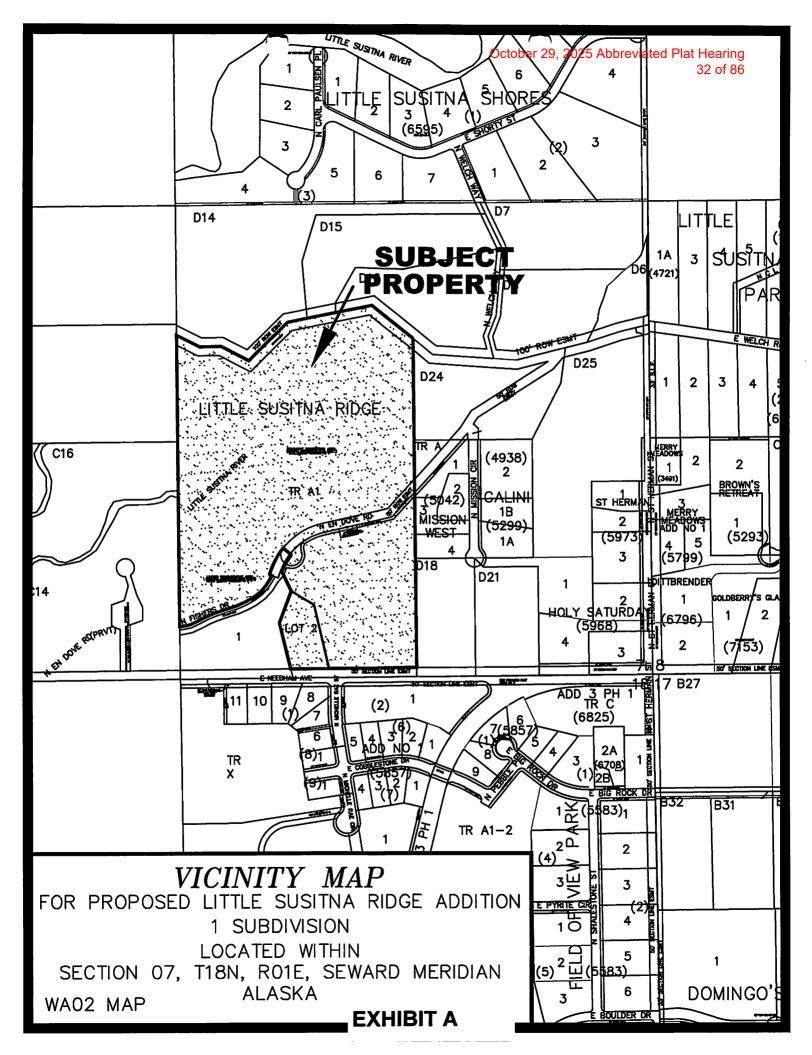

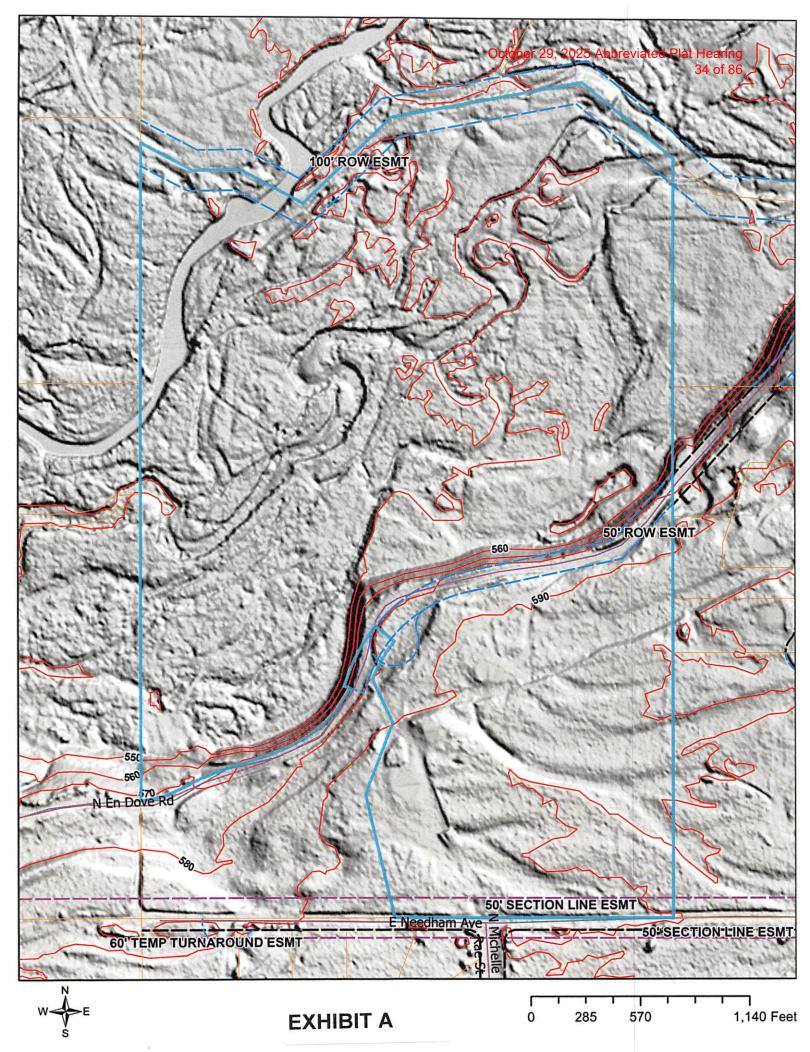

At the request of the property owners, we have performed a soils review and related preliminary design work for the referenced proposed subdivision. The project will create 1 new lot and one large remainder lot from an existing tract by creating new lotlines as shown on the attached drawing. Our soils evaluation included logging one new testhole, review of our earlier work, review of the provided topography information, review of aerial imagery, and our other observations at the site. See the attached testhole location and topography map for details.

Topography. The project site forms an incomplete tall rectangle north of E. Needham Avenue, and west of N. Mission Circle. Terrain varies in elevation with a high region near the southern border of the project that contains a steep drop to the north lower region which contains gently rolling terrain as well as portions of the Little Su River, which bisects the property. The total elevation differential indicated from the provided topographical map is approximately 62'. Some steep areas with slopes exceeding 25% exist within the project and are delineated on the attached drawing.

Soils & Vegetation. The proposed 2- acre Lot 2 and the remainder Lot 1 contain cleared areas with a few existing structures and driveways. A gravel pad, shop building and loading ramp exist on lot 2. The native vegetation remaining on the parent parcel consists primarily of mature birch, spruce, and cottonwood, with lesser brush/grasses scattered throughout. As shown on the attached drawing one new testhole was dug on a common lotline to evaluate soil conditions, and a copy of the log is included with this report. Near surface soils included a thin organic mat and silty topsoils over clean sands and gravels extending to 13.5', which is typical for the area. Copies of the testhole log and the location/topography map are attached.

Groundwater. Groundwater was not encountered in the testhole which was dug to a depth of 13.5'. Portions of the Little Su River pass through the low region central to the larger Lot 1, and would be expected to have a relatively shallow water table. However,

adequate other higher ground areas exist as well, and the river lies more than 100 away 38 of 86 from any potential useable area. Separation to groundwater is not expected to be a limiting factor for the proposed lots.

<u>Useable Areas.</u> The proposed lots have a few limitations on areas defined by MSB code as *useable septic area* or *useable building area*. Useable septic areas will be limited by lotlines, setbacks to existing water wells, steep areas and related setbacks, and setbacks to existing structures. For useable building area, lotlines, utility easements, and ROW/PUE setbacks will be limiting factors. For both proposed lots, adequate unencumbered area exists to readily meet the code requirements. Based on the available soils and water table information, topography, MSB Title 43 Code definitions, and our observations at the site, proposed Lot 2 will contain over 10,000 square feet of contiguous useable septic area, and an additional 10,000 square feet of useable building area. Proposed Lot 1 contains more than 400,000 square feet of area and does not require useable area verification.

<u>Drainage Plan.</u> The new lot and tract have existing access and no new roads will need to be constructed. Existing drainage patterns are not expected to change as a result of the lot line changes. As no new road construction is planned, no formal drainage plan is required. However, we have indicated general existing drainage patterns on the attached map.

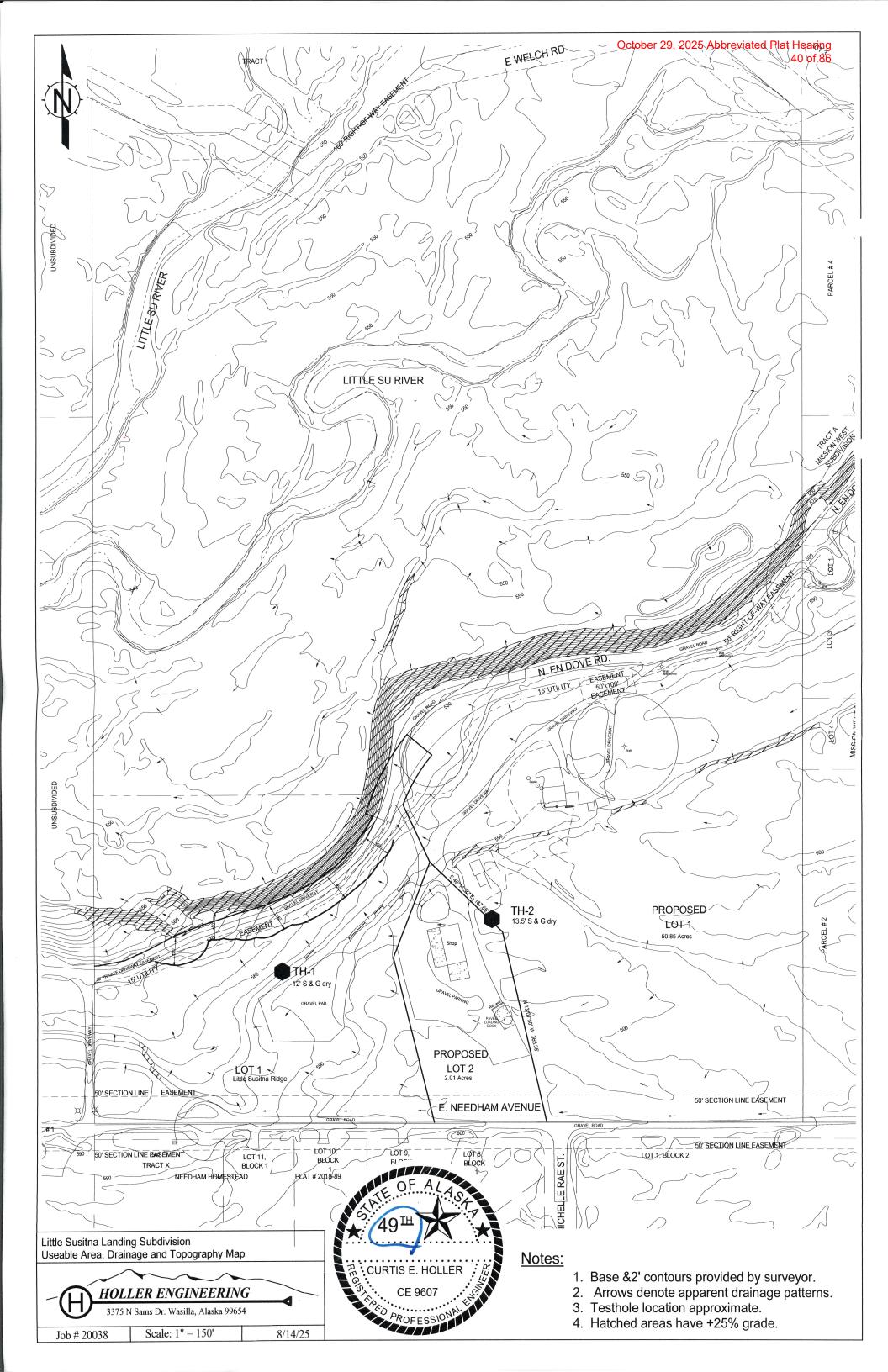

DISCUSSION: The proposed subdivision is creating two lots. Access is from N. Prospect Drive and W. Sunrise Drive, both roads are Borough maintained roads.

Soils Report: A geotechnical report was submitted (Exhibit B), pursuant to MSB 43.20.281(A). James Rowland, Registered Professional Engineer, notes that a soils investigation has been completed for the proposed Whit's Woods. The investigation was to determine if the subsurface soil and groundwater conditions are suitable for conventional on-site wastewater disposal systems meeting the state's regulatory requirements. Two test holes were dug to a depth of 12'. No groundwater was encountered. The soil conditions found within the proposed subdivision are suitable for conventional on-site wastewater disposal systems meeting the state's regulatory requirements, 18 AAC 72. Based on the test hole data and observations of topography, there is a minimum of 10,000 square feet of usable building area and 10,000 square feet of contiguous usable septic area within each of the proposed lots in conformance with Matanuska-Susitna Borough Subdivision Regulations, Title 43.20.281. Topographic mapping, As-Built

information, and test hole locations are shown on the agenda plat. Based on the supplied as-built, there is a shed that will need to be relocated prior to recordation (Recommendation #4).

Comments:

Department of Public Works (Exhibit C) has no comments.

MSB Development Services (Exhibit E):

- Permit Center Each access or encroachment constructed during subdivision development shall be reported to the Permit Center for documentation.
- Code Compliance There are no open or outstanding violations on existing Lot 6 or 7. As long as the shed is removed along the proposed west property line adjustment. If the shed is not removed/relocated, it will be in violation of MSB Setbacks per 17.55 side lot line (Recommendation #4). Code Compliance does not object to the platting action.

<u>Utilities</u>: (Exhibit F) ENSTAR has no comments or recommendations. GCI has no comments or objections. MEA did not respond. MTA did not respond.

At the time of staff report write-up, there were no responses to the Request for Comments from ADF&G; USACE; Community Council #1 Meadow Lakes; Fire Service Area #136 West Lakes; Road Service Area #27 Meadow Lakes; MSB Community Development, Emergency Services, Assessments, or Planning Division; MEA or MTA.

CONCLUSION: The abbreviated plat of Whit's Woods is consistent with AS 29.40.070 Platting Regulations and MSB 43.15.025 Abbreviated Plats. There were no objections from any federal or state agencies, Borough departments, or utilities. There were no objections to the plat from the public in response to the Notice of Public Hearing. <u>DISCUSSION:</u> The proposed subdivision is creating one lot from TRACT A and TRACT B, ASLS 73-004 Subdivision, containing 5.16 acres +/-. Also to create a second lot from ASLS 72-051 and TRACT A ASLS 70-015, containing 0.53 acres +/-. The proposed subdivision is heard under MSB 43.15.025, *Abbreviated Plats* and MSB 43.15.054(G), *Exemptions*. Elimination of common lot lines are exempt from survey and monumentation requirements and allows the surveyor to use record information from the prior plat.

COMMENTS:

There were no objections or concerns received from Borough departments, outside agencies or the public at the time of this staff report.

CONCLUSION

The plat of Massay Manor is consistent with AS 29.40.070 Platting Regulations, MSB 43.15.025 Abbreviated Plats and MSB 43.15.054(G) Exemptions. Plats to remove lot lines are exempt from

provisions of the code, which require soils report submittals, legal and physical access, as-built survey, and topographic information. There were no objections received from borough departments, outside agencies or the public at the time of this staff report.

FINDINGS of FACT:

- 1. The abbreviated plat of Massay Manor is consistent with AS 29.40.070 *Platting Regulations*, MSB 43.15.025 *Abbreviated Plats*, and MSB 43.15.054(G) *Exemptions*.
- 2. This plat combines two lots within Treasure Island Subdivision, lessening the lot density in the area.
- 3. There were no objections from any borough departments, outside agencies or the public.
- 4. An elimination of common lot line plat is exempt from provisions of the code, which require soils report submittals, legal and physical access requirements, as-built survey or topographic information.
- 5. MSB 43.15.054(G) allows the surveyor to use record information from the recorded plat of Massay Manor (Plat #80-18), and does not require additional monumentation.

RECOMMENDED CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:

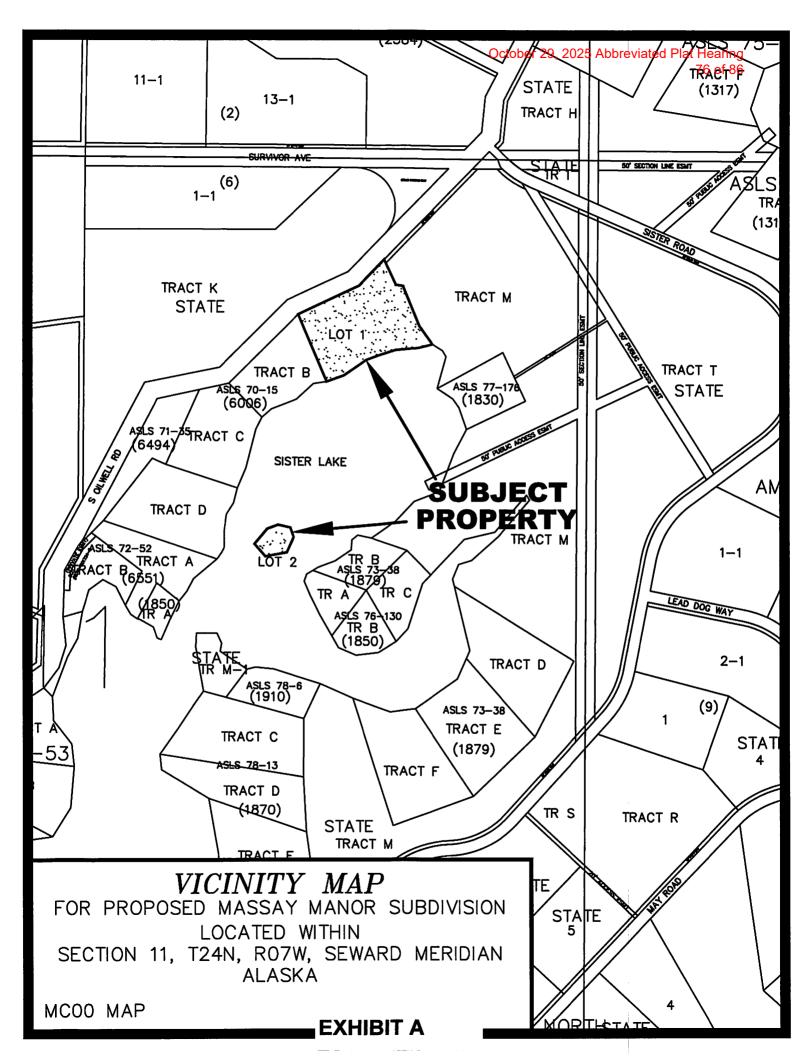

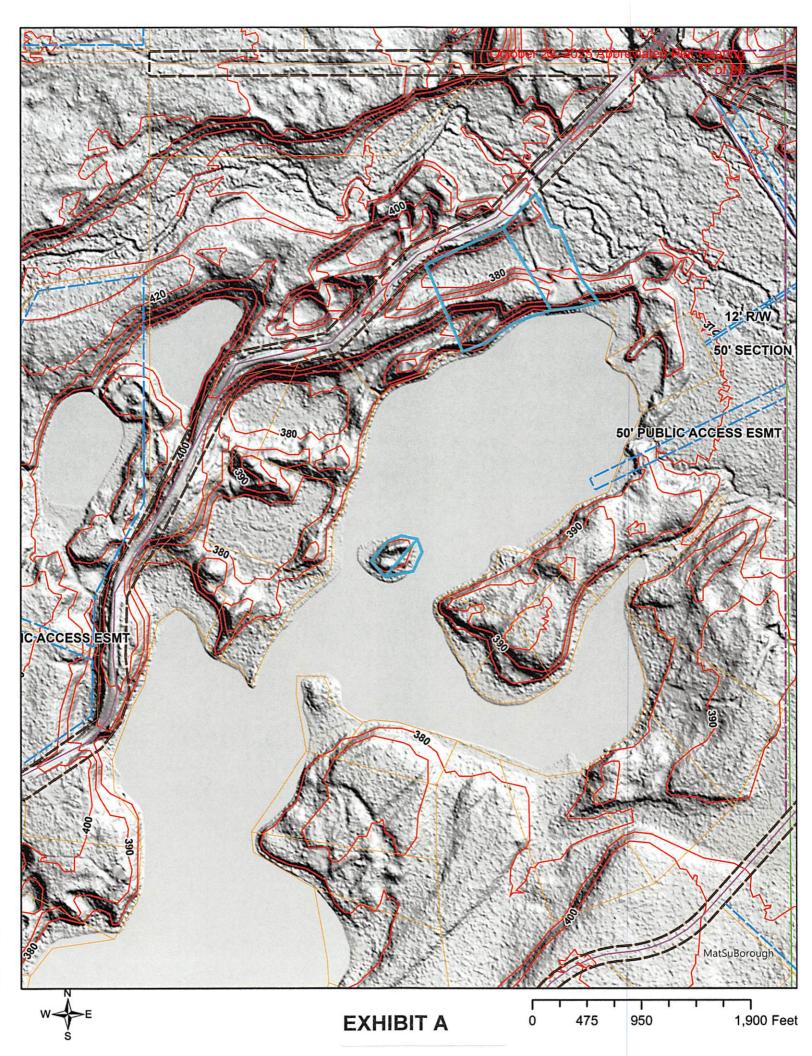

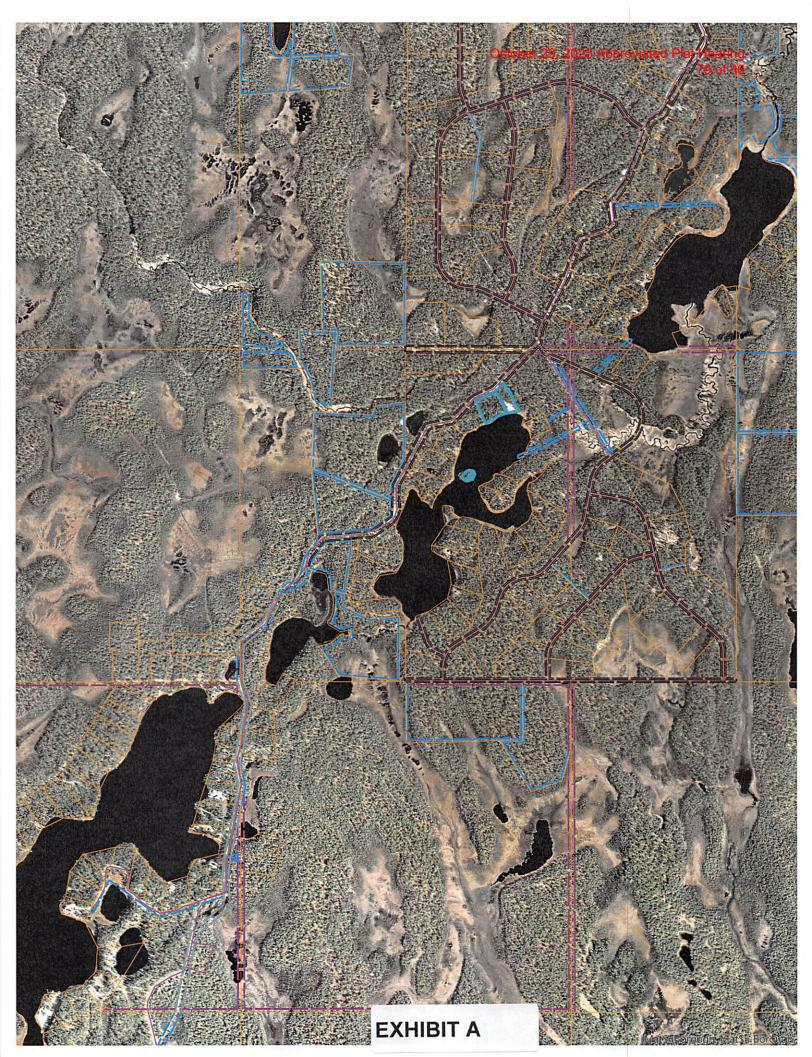

The Corps of Engineers (Corps) does not have any specific comments regarding the RFC for Massay Manor CR.

Department of the Army authorization is required if anyone proposes to place dredged and/or fill material into waters of the U.S., including wetlands and/or perform work in navigable waters of the U.S.

Section 404 of the Clean Water Act requires that a DA permit be obtained for the placement or discharge of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the U.S., including jurisdictional wetlands (33 U.S.C. 1344). The Corps defines wetlands as those areas that are inundated or saturated by surface or groundwater at a frequency and duration sufficient to support, and under normal circumstances do support, a prevalence of vegetation typically adapted for life in saturated soil conditions.

Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 requires that a DA permit be obtained for structures or work in or affecting navigable waters of the U.S. (33 U.S.C. 403). Section 10 waters are those waters subject to the ebb and flow of the tide shoreward to the mean high water mark, and/or other waters identified by the Alaska District. Aquaculture structures and work would require Section 10 Authorization.

The applicant is welcome to submit a preapplication meeting request, a jurisdictional determination request, or a permit application directly to our general mailbox (regpagemaster@usace.army.mil) and they will be assigned a project manager to assist them.
