The event hosted over 80 different transportation related projects and programs and invited the public to discuss them with staff members. Cole Branham staffed a booth covering the Borough projects listed above. He talked to many people about the projects and answered questions.

Public Comments

Members of the public made the following verbal comments about each project.



49th State Street Pathway

 Which side will the pathway be on? Response: We are currently evaluating alternatives to determine which side of the road the pathway will go on.

Caswell Lakes Rd/ Bendapole Rd/ Passthebait Ave/ Lostaspinner St

• I am glad to see the previous investment to upgrade Caswell Lakes Road and Bendapole Road will be protected by paving these roads before they degrade.

Cheri Lake Dr/ Karen Ave/ King Arthur Dr

Project staff did not receive any comments about this project.

Edgerton Parks Road – Mt. Trails Drive and Pathway

- Which side will the path go on? Response: The preliminary plan shows the path on the
 east side of Mountain Trails Drive and the north side of Edgerton Parks Road. We are
 currently surveying and collecting field data that will help in the final determination of
 which side the path will be on.
- There is currently nowhere for pedestrians to safely walk along the road.
- The roads are in need of repair.
- People speed on the road.
- This project is important to bikers, runners, and walkers.
- I am concerned about how much property this project will take from the property owners.
 Response: It is too early in the design process to determine how much right-of-way may be needed. Our design team will work to minimize purchasing private property for right-of-way.

Engstrom Road to Trunk Road Corridor

- Where will this connection be made to Trunk Road? Response: We are currently looking into two alternatives. A northern connection that will extend off the east-west leg of Engstrom Road near Feldspar Circle and a southern connection near Glade Court.
- We prefer a connection further north that captures all the traffic heading south from the newer neighborhoods.

Fern Street Upgrade and Pathway

- The blind hill at Fern Street and Leota Street should be fixed. Response: Our design team is aware of the blind hill and will work to improve sight distance during the design.
- There are two blind hills that are risky for drivers. The first is at Leota Street and the Second is at Bluff Vista.



- The corner of Leota Street and Fern has drainage issues and flooding on adjacent properties. We would like this to be considered in design. Response: Thank you for the information. We will pass it along to our design team.
- Please fix the frost heaves and blind hills.
- I liked when the road was not connected between Knik Goose Bay Road and Fairview Loop. I liked my quiet neighborhood.
- Fern is a nice short cut for getting onto Knik Goose Bay Road.
- Do not increase the speed limit.
- This project will increase speeding.
- A path will provide safe access to the path on Knik Goose Bay Road.
- A path is needed. The road is narrow, and it results in people walking, riding, and pushing strollers on the road.
- We are very excited for the bike path.
- Four wheelers are a problem. They drive too fast.
- Sections of the road are in very poor condition and narrow with no shoulder.

Hemmer Road Extension South

 Congestion at the intersection of France Road and the Palmer-Wasilla Highway is a problem.

Hidden Hills Reconstruction

• When will these improvements be made? Response: Construction of the first phase is planned for 2023.

Lakes Blvd. Upgrade

This road is in poor condition and the project is needed.

Lucille Street and Pathway Upgrade

MSBSD Shaw Elementary Access

A turn lane would help but I don't think it will solve the congestion issue. Response: We
are currently working on a traffic study to look at the intersection and determine ways to
address congestion during peak traffic periods.

Point MacKenzie Road Reconstruction MP 0-7

 When will construction begin? Response: Construction is planned for 2024. The Alaska DOT&PF has a project planned for 2023 to repair earthquake damage from the 2018 earthquake on Point Mackenzie Road. This Borough project will happen after DOT&Pf's project is complete.

Smith Road Extension and Pathway

- These improvements are needed and will improve safety for recreationalist and neighbors.
- I like the idea of the path going on the south side.
- The roads are in poor condition with no walking facilities. Vehicle and foot traffic has increased a lot the last 20 years.

Tex-Al Drive Upgrade and Extension

- Will this connect Wasilla Fishhook Road to Palmer Fishhook Road? Response: The
 proposed project is to connect the east and west leg of Tex-Al Drive, which will connect
 the two Fishhook roads.
- People drive too fast on this road, making this connection will only encourage them to drive faster.
- We need the bike path so pedestrians will have a safe place to walk.
- There are a couple of blind hills that make it unsafe for cars and pedestrians.
